TITLE: Technology Support Specialist - System Services

SUMMARY: The Technology Support Specialist - System Services is a non-certified, 12-month position that serves the entire district.

The primary function of this position is to assist in supporting all technology used within the district. This includes, but is not limited to, MacBooks, iMacs, iPads, ChromeBooks, Windows PCs, printers, and various software (especially Google Apps).

To successfully meet this job requirement, the Technology Support Specialist must research, evaluate, document, and deploy appropriate technologies. The position also requires experience and knowledge of the district's student information system and data while maintaining up-to-date knowledge of the applications and policies. Other responsibilities for this position include maintaining hardware, overseeing software upgrades, and training staff.

The Director of Technology and Information Services may also assign other duties.

This position requires an individual who is reliable, punctual, self-reliant, and motivated to learn different technologies while contributing to create a positive working environment.
